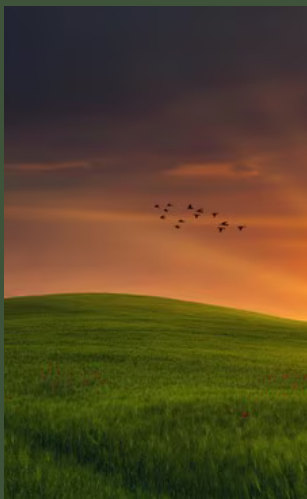

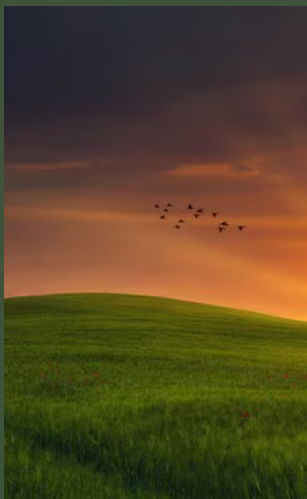

Through international cooperation, practical learning experiences, and capacity-building activities, the project supports young people in developing the skills, knowledge, and confidence needed to lead environmental and social initiatives.

The project brings together participants from different European countries who share a common interest in **sustainability, climate action, community engagement, and youth participation**. By working together, participants have the opportunity to exchange ideas, learn from different perspectives, and create meaningful solutions to environmental challenges.

Green Horizons focuses on **strengthening youth leadership** and supporting the development of youth-led organisations and initiatives. Participants gain valuable insights into how NGOs operate, how community projects are developed, and how young people can play an active role in shaping a greener and more sustainable future.

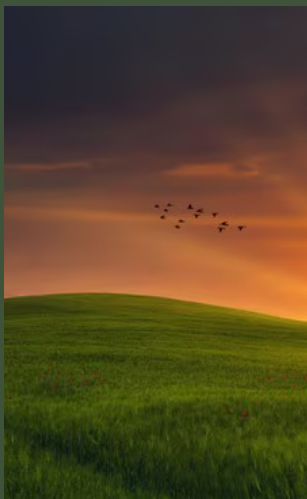

- lead your own NGO

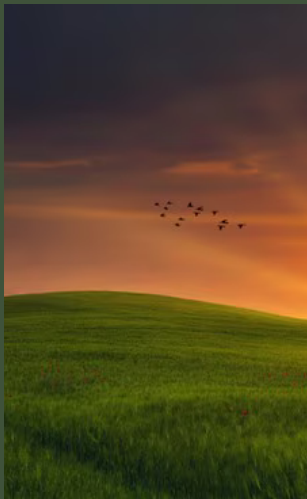
We will visit NGOs and learn about their approach and impact, as well as NGO-related regulations and policies in the partner countries

Together with other participants, develop and finalize your business plans for a youth-led NGO and practice presenting your NGO's mission and objectives to a panel of experts.

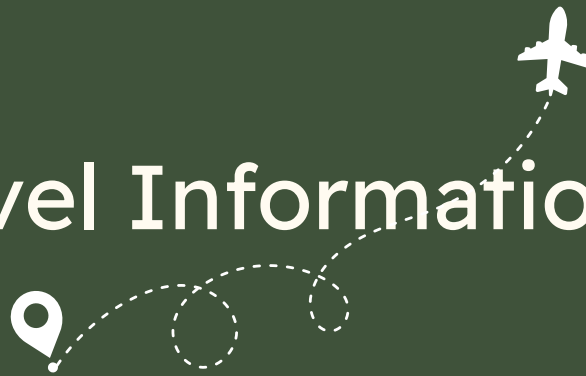
After the program, participants will receive a Youth Pass certification, reflecting participation and achievements during the bootcamp.

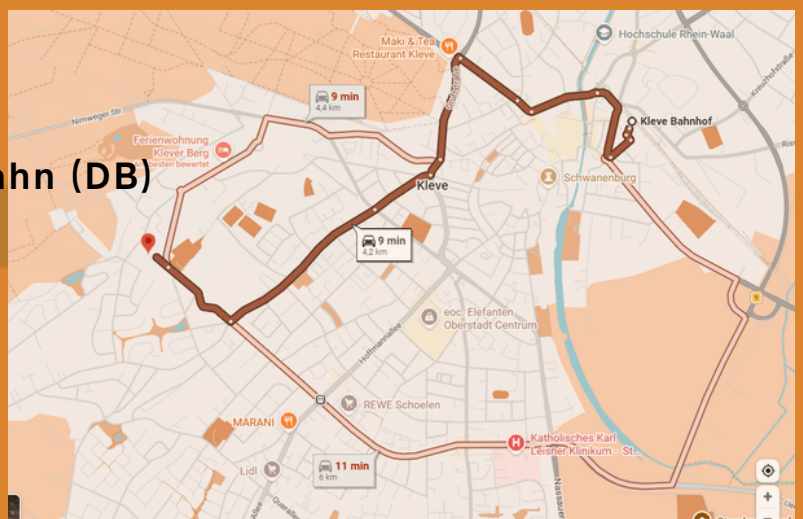

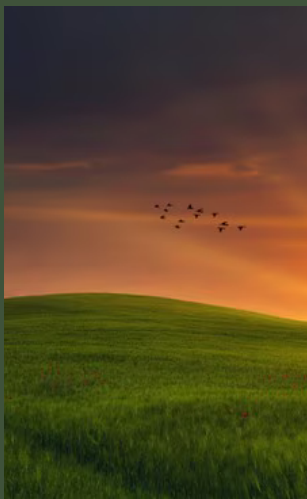
